

# Elementary School Ice Cream Sales Hurt Children's Health and Waste Taxpayer Dollars

Selling ice cream to elementary students is a big business for Houston area schools. Most school districts in the region sell ice cream and other junk food in elementary school cafeterias at lunch to raise money.

### Annual Elementary School Ice Cream Sales 2024-2025 School Year



Ice cream sales revenue varies widely across districts. **Cy-Fair ISD sold almost \$1 million worth of ice cream** to elementary students in the 2024-2025 school year while Conroe ISD sold less than \$20,000 worth of ice cream the same year.

### Average Annual Ice Cream Sales Per Student 2024-2025 School Year



We might expect larger districts to sell more ice cream. Adjusting sales based on the number of students enrolled—the amount of ice cream sold per student—tells a more complicated story. Tomball ISD sold the most ice cream per student in the 2024-2025 school year: \$27.36 in ice cream

sales for each elementary student! Conroe ISD sold the least per student (\$0.66 per student). Most Conroe ISD elementary schools do not offer ice cream in the cafeteria.

These average numbers conceal a lot of variation at the individual school and student level. Even in the districts that sell the most ice cream, many students never buy ice cream at school. Some students only buy ice cream once a week. However, some students buy ice cream every single school day—and some students buy two or more each day!

Schools usually sell ice cream at the same time they serve the main meal. There is no adult present who encourages students to eat their lunch before eating dessert. As expected, most children eat their ice cream first! This spoils their appetite for the more nutritious foods on their tray. School lunch periods are short, children eat slowly, and there are many distractions as students socialize with their friends. As a result, some students eat their ice cream first and then throw the rest of their lunch away.

School lunches are required to meet robust nutrition standards.<sup>1</sup> However, ice cream and other desserts and snacks are sold separately as “a la carte” items. Cafeteria “a la carte” sales are lightly regulated.<sup>2</sup> Cafeterias that sell ice cream every day with lunch promote unhealthy eating patterns. In the cafeteria, there is no parent or other adult to guide healthy eating choices. Instead, students as young as five years old are left to their own devices in choosing from a smorgasbord of unhealthy treats which have been engineered by large corporations to be tempting and addictive.

School lunches are heavily subsidized by taxpayers. Firstly, schools receive free and subsidized ingredients from the US Department of Agriculture via various purchasing programs.<sup>3</sup> Secondly, nearly two-thirds of Texas students receive school lunches for free or at a reduced cost,<sup>4</sup> with taxpayers paying the difference. Students who receive a free or reduced lunch often buy ice cream “a la carte” with money from home.<sup>5</sup> When a student throws out a school lunch they are not just wasting food but also taxpayer dollars.

## What's On the Menu?

Some adults may remember schools serving small cups of ice cream with little flat wooden “spoons” – a small, occasional treat. Today, however, many schools boast ice cream menus that rival convenience stores! While some schools limit choices to smaller, lower-calorie products, many schools sell ice cream products with high calories, lots of added sugar, and long lists of unnatural and harmful ingredients.

### Why Is This Important?

The purpose of school nutrition departments is to protect the health of students. This means feeding students nutritious meals, teaching healthy eating habits, and ensuring students have the right fuel to be ready to learn. It is grossly inappropriate for public school cafeterias to profit by selling junk food.

Cafeteria “a la carte” sales of desserts and other junk food promote extremely unhealthy eating patterns—some students eat ice cream for lunch every day, many students eat their ice cream first and throw out nutritious food, and some students buy multiple ice creams every day.

**It is grossly inappropriate for public school cafeterias to profit by selling junk food.**

### Excessive Added Sugar Harms Children’s Health

Pediatricians and The American Heart Association recommend that children eat less than 25 grams of added sugar per day.<sup>6</sup> Children who eat too much sugar are at risk of serious health problems, including diabetes, obesity, tooth decay, heart failure, and fatty liver disease. Many of the ice cream products available in elementary schools contain more than half of the maximum amount of added sugar that children should eat in a day!

# School Nutrition Policies that Protect Kids' Health

## Best:

---

Elementary schools do not sell ice cream or other desserts “a la carte” in the cafeteria.

## Good

---

- Elementary schools limit “a la carte” ice cream and dessert sales to once a week or less often.
- Students may only purchase a single dessert.
- The elementary “a la carte” menu is limited to lower calorie, lower sugar options (100 calories or less, 9 g added sugars or less) and products include no harmful ingredients (e.g. high fructose corn syrup, artificial colors or flavors).
- Students are encouraged to eat their lunch first by delaying dessert sales until later in the lunch period.

## Worst

---

- Ice cream and other desserts are available for sale daily.
- Students are allowed to buy multiple desserts per day.
- The “a la carte” menu includes high-calorie, high-sugar options (>100 calories, >9g added sugar).
- Desserts are sold at the same time as the main meal.

# What Can You Do to Protect Elementary Students' Health?

## School Nutrition Directors, District Superintendents, and School Board Members:

---

Those in school district leadership positions can immediately improve student health by implementing the “Good” or “Best” practices described above. Most elementary schools in the country do not sell junk food in the cafeteria.<sup>7</sup> School district leaders should investigate their districts’ “a la carte” policies and make sure they prioritize nutrition, especially for the youngest students.

## Principals and Teachers:

---

Frontline school employees are charged with guiding and protecting students every day. If you are troubled by the cafeteria selling desserts to students, you are not alone! Speak up internally and express your concerns to district administration about the impact of “a la carte” junk food sales on elementary students’ health, behavior, and readiness to learn.

## Parents and Community Members:

---

Public schools belong to us all, and it is our right and duty as citizens to hold them accountable. Advocate with your school’s nutrition department and school board for healthier policies. # The Financial Benefit of School Ice Cream Sales is Small

School nutrition directors choose to sell ice cream in elementary schools to raise additional funds for their departments. However, ice cream manufacturers and distributors receive most of the revenue.

Tomball ISD, for example, charges students \$1.40 for an ice cream sandwich. The cost from the distributor for that ice cream sandwich is \$0.81.<sup>8</sup> Across all “a la carte” ice cream products,

Tomball ISD has a 42 percent profit margin. Therefore, Tomball ISD's gross annual elementary ice cream sales of \$260,000 only generate \$110,000 in additional funding for the district, a trivial sum in the context of a \$230 million annual district budget. It is offensive to sacrifice student nutrition for such a paltry sum.

## How Was Data Gathered for This Report?

Data on elementary school “a la carte” sales for the 2024-2025 school year was collected from 12 Houston area school districts representing 558 elementary schools with over 377,000 students. Data was gathered by submitting public information requests as provided for by the Texas Public Information Act. Each district was provided with a copy of its data for the Director of Child Nutrition to review and was asked to describe the district's policies regarding elementary school “a la carte” sales. More detailed data is available in the appendix and from the author upon request.
